The ACC and Compliance Committees will conduct the Fall Neighborhood Canvas from October 1-31, 2025.

When you see committee members walking around or driving through the neighborhood, they are working on

keeping our community running smoothly; ensuring that our policies and rules are being followed. If you happen to see them, feel free to stop them and ask questions!

Unkempt yards, homes in need of cleaning and painting, and improper exterior modifications are just a few items they are looking for. These efforts not only enhance curb appeal but also contribute to a positive impression for visitors and potential homebuyers.



Inspect your fascia and trim at least once a year, particularly after severe weather events.



What To Look For:

Signs of Damage: Visible cracks, splitting, warping, discoloration, water stains.

Peeling Paint: Cracking, peeling, or flaking paint may signal moisture intrusion or

age-related wear.

Soft or Rotting Wood: Gently press on the trim and fascia with your fingers. If it feels soft or spongy, it may indicate water damage or rot.

Pest Infestation: Look for holes, nests around eaves, or gnaw marks, which can indicate the presence of insects like termites or carpenter ants, or rodents.

Sagging Gutters: Damaged fascia may not be able to adequately support gutters, leading to sagging or detachment.

Signs of Water Leaks in the Attic: Check the ceilings for stains, wet insulation,

or mold, which can indicate water damage from compromised fascia.





Consult with a Professional: If you're unsure about the extent of the damage or how to best address it, consider hiring a qualified contractor or home inspector to assess the situation and provide recommendations.
